We do have one additional revenue of \$20,000 from the in-lieu tax agreement that will help, other than that there is not much change. We currently have a proposed local law that will allow to exceed the current tax cap. However, every attempt will be made to hold to the tax cap.

The proposed Senior Partial Exemption increase may not have a direct impact to the budget, but will have an impact on other tax payers. This will allow for seniors to age in place.
